## 2014 Charitable Giving & Holiday Office Hours

We'd like to take this time to personally thank each and every one of you for your continued trust and support in us. Without you, our business would not be possible. We truly value the relationships and friendships we have built with you and your families over the years and look forward to many more.

This year we have made the following contributions to local, national and world communities in your honor:

- **American Red Cross of Northeast Indiana:** Provides relief to victims of disaster and help people prevent, prepare for, and respond to emergencies.
- **Community Foundation of Greater Fort Wayne:** Organized to channel gifts from individual and corporate donors to a variety of charitable organizations in the local community. We made donations to seven local charities through the Community Foundation this year and the Community Foundation matched 100% of each gift. Below are the charities:
  1. **Allen County CASA Coalition:** Recruits, trains and supervises community volunteers to advocate for an abused or neglected child by providing objective information and recommendations.
  2. **Erin's House:** Support for children, teens, and their families who have suffered the death of a loved one.
  3. **Fort Wayne Rescue Mission:** A faith-based, nonprofit organization, providing restorative care to men, women and children experiencing a homeless crisis. They serve Fort Wayne, Allen County and its nine surrounding counties. The Mission is comprised of four ministries, or houses, that function as communities of compassion.
  4. **Hope House:** Provides homeless, chemically-dependent women with opportunities to pursue recovery and self-sufficiency in a healthy supportive living environment.
  5. **Matthew 25 Health and Dental Clinic:** Provides free primary healthcare services to uninsured, low-income residents of Allen County.
  6. **Turnstone:** The only not-for-profit organization within northeast Indiana that provides a full range of rehabilitative, educational, wellness, athletic and recreational programs and facilities to persons with physical disabilities and their families.
  7. **Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home:** Provides compassionate care to alleviate suffering and ensure quality of life for those affected by serious illness.
- **Give Kids the World:** GKTW exists only to fulfill the wishes of all children with life threatening illnesses and their families from around the world to experience a memorable, joyful,



cost-free visit to the Central Florida attractions, and to enjoy the magic of Give Kids the World Village.

- **Homes for our Troops:** This nonprofit organization builds specially adapted, mortgage-free homes nationwide for the most severely injured Veterans from Iraq and Afghanistan. Most of these Veterans are multiple amputees, paraplegic, quadriplegic or suffered severe traumatic brain injury (TBI).
- **Mustard Seed:** Provides basic home furnishings for families formerly displaced by fire or other causes.
- **Salvation Army:** "Doing the Most Good." Their mission - to feed, to clothe, to comfort, to care in God's name without discrimination.

These charities are vetted for their efficiency in deployment of charitable income. They must not use more than 20% of income to operate their mission. Most of these organizations are 85% efficient or better.
